Class list will be posted Wednesday, September 9. Please note that these are thoughtful and collaborative decisions based on best fits for student and overall class dynamics.

As was the case in the Spring, we will be restricting additional adults in our school. Please drop students off and remain off school property. If you need to speak to a staff member, please make an appointment through the office or contact that staff member directly, beforehand.

Students will be grouped in learning pods/cohorts of no more than 60. Typically, this would be 2 classes that could partner up.

Mask use is not mandatory in all situations, but may be required in certain instances. Staff will go over this with students in the first week.
